

## General Motors Spring Hill Assembly Plant

## **Project Overview**

General Motors' Spring Hill, Tennessee assembly plant will begin the transition to become the company's third vehicle manufacturing site to produce electric vehicles (EVs). The all-new Cadillac

LYRIQ will be the irst EV produced at Spring Hill. The facility will build both traditionally powered Cadillac products and EVs.

Irving Materials delivered 27,187 cubic yards (20,786 cubic metres) of concrete made with CarbonCure, reducing **375,000 pounds (170,097 kilograms) of CO<sub>2</sub> from the atmosphere.** 

That's equivalent to 211 acres (85 hectares) of forest sequestering  $CO_2$  for a year.
