Project Overview

Whether domestic expansion or international landing pad, Fox Hill Business Park offers up to 2.5 million square feet of Class A industrial and distribution excellence in the heart of Greenville County, South Carolina – among America's fastest-growing economic centers.

Located in Greenville County, South Carolina, Fox Hill Business Park is served by immediate access to I-385 linked to I-85. With 70 freight lines in the Greenville area, overnight trucking is available to most of the Southeast while 44% of the United States population is accessible within one-day for quick distribution to multiple hubs of industry and commerce.

Thomas Concrete delivered 8,809 cubic yards (6,375 cubic metres) of CarbonCure concrete for the construction of Fox Hill Business Park, reducing more than 130,000 pounds (58,000 kilograms) of carbon emissions. That's equivalent to 78 acres (32 hectares) of forest absorbing carbon for a year.
